Set Up:

Colors: green yellow lt purple

Herbs: high john, pennyroyal, wood betony, apple blossom

Stones: bloodstone, jade aquamarine

Tree: dogwood

Gods/Goddesses: - Isis, Morrighan, Artemis, Cybele, Hecate, Astarte, Athene, Minerva

Symbolism: energy breaks into the open; growing, prospering, exploring. New beginnings; balance of Light and Dark. Breaking illusions. Seeing the truth in your life however much it may hurt.

CLEANSING CIRCLE

Cleanse with besom.

CAST CIRCLE

I cast this circle about
All good in, all negative out
Three times round the circle I go
Keeping in balance high and low
The energy is gathered, the circle claims
